GUARANA ARA



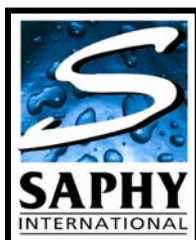
Its origin Guarana is a Brazilian fruit. It grows in Amazonie where the climate is perfect for this plant. An old legend explains the Guarana origin: Indians from the region think that the fruit represents the God's eyes. In fact, when the Guarana becomes ripe, the shell opens and a dark stone surrounded by a white pulp appears; it looks like human eyes.

The plant is known under the nomination Guarana. A well-looked after Guarana seedling can produce fruits during 40 to 50 years.

In 1905, the doctor Luiz Perreira Barreto discovered the energetic and gustative virtues of the fruit and decided to make a refreshing Guarana-based drink.
